Drugs included:

- Controlled, non-controlled, and over the counter drugs
- All solid dosage pharmaceutical products
- Liquids, e.g., cough syrup, in original consumer containers with lids tightened to prevent leakage (leaking containers can be secured in appropriately sized plastic bag.)

NOT Accepted:

- Intravenous solutions, injectables, syringes, or medical waste due to potential hazard posed by blood-borne pathogens.
- Illicit substances such as marijuana or methamphetamine
